Information about the period underwear



Your period underwear will last for years if you take good care of them.



Wash them before wearing them for the first time:

 Put them in a laundry bag and wash in the machine, or hand wash them in a bucket. Do not scrub them or use fabric softeners.



During your period, rinse them:

- After wearing them, rinse the underwear in COLD water until the water runs clear. Do not soak, rub or scrub. Once they are rinsed, you can hang them up until you have a few to wash at the same time.
- If you need to change your underwear while you are out, you can put the used underwear into the black bag until you get home and then rinse them.



Wash in a machine or hand wash:

- Wash them in a washing machine in COLD water. You can wash them in the same wash as your other clothes. Put them in a laundry bag to protect them from zips.
- If you hand wash, move them in and out of a bucket of water. The movement in and out of the water will clean the underwear. Squeeze them to release excess water.
- Do not leave them to soak. Do not rub or scrub.
 Do not use fabric softeners or stain removers.



Drying the underwear

• Dry in the fresh air. Do not use a drier.
